Where The Bears Are Actor George Unda Sets Sights on Mobile's Upcoming Bleather 5: "The Hunt"

Mobile, Alabama - George Unda has known he was a bear. But he didn't have any idea he was about to become a bear seen in the woods all across America and the internet. The 30 year old Californian now has a starring role in season two of the internet "bear" comedy sensation, *Where The Bears Are*.

Unda is about to be this year's special guest for Bleather 5, Mobile, Alabama's annual Bear/Leather/Men celebration, set for July 26-28 in the Port City.

His hometown is San Bernardino, just southeast of L.A. in Southern California, and he has a sister (who has a very hot and talented brother.) Ask Unda



if he's "hooked up" and he'll simply say "I'm not single." He met his hunky and bearish man while filming episodes of *Where The Bears Are*.

Unda was asked to audition for his role during an actual filming of an episode of season two. Why not, he thought. He'dbe lucky to get a minor role. Unda was

asked two read for three different roles, but captured the part of Detective Marcus Martinez after his second audition.

"The whole idea was fresh," says Unda. "I think it shows a good example of the L.A. Bear scene. The show also shows guys around the country what Los Angeles is like and what our bears are like."

Also appealing to Unda was the project's grass root support, mostly donations of dollars from those who enjoy the show.

"I believe it is groundbreaking," he says, "and I can't believe a network like Logo hasn't picked up on it yet. Bears are a huge community. We show a good element of gay men outside the Hollywood cookie cutter images.

Unda believes the bear community is leading the charge to break the stereotypical image of gay men. "I'm flattered to be part of the movement," he says.

The weekend of July 26-28, 30 year old Unda brings his bearish self to Mobile, Alabama. He'll be the invited guest for Mobile Bleather Weekend 5, the fifth summer get together of bears, leathermen and, well, MEN on the Gulf Coast. It's new territory for the man from San Bernardino. Among many "requirements," Mr.Under will assist with the annual Mr. Gulf Coast Bear Contest.

"The South is kind of foreign to me," says Unda. "I did spend the night in Mobile once. I was in a hotel along I-10, but only slept through the night. To me, the South is another country all to itself. What I've seen tells me everybody is
