The production numbers by Top 5 Show Club of the Year Finalists: Bourbon Pub & Parade, The Corner Pocket, Four Seasons, The Golden Lantern and Oz were astounding! Last year's Entertainer of the Year Gia GiaVanni just brought the evening to a climax with her incredible mix!
